Hole 9 Yardage

Tee	Current Yardage	Proposed Yardage
Black	451	451
Blue	440	425
White	400	390-400
Red	370	290-320

Hole 9 Notes:

1. Extensive tee clearing to open up tee shot and view of the hole.
2. Modify tees as needed to improve useable surface area.
3. Add new forward tee to improve red tee yardage to a "fair" distance for a par 4 hole.
4. Remove fairway bunker.
5. Rebuild the green, expanding the size and re-shaping the surface.
6. Remove left side bunker at the green and rebuild the right side bunker.
7. Add zoysia fairway around the green and out to the cart path.



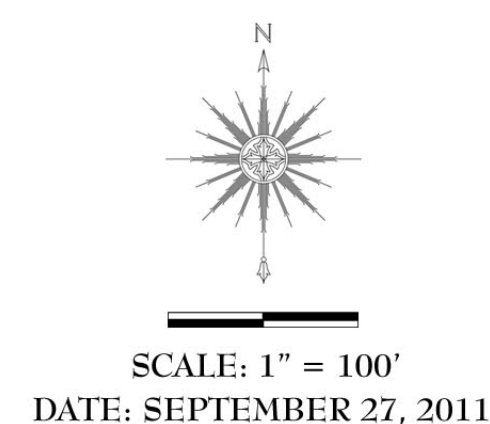
Hole 8 Yardage

Tee	Current Yardage	Proposed Yardage
Black	224	224
Blue	210	195-205
White	170	160-170
Red	144	115-130

Hole 8 Notes:

1. Extensive tree clearing around the green to open up airflow as much as possible.
2. Rebuild the green, enlarging it and re-shaping to create more interest and better drainage.
3. Remove bunker on the right and add bunker to the left. Rebuild existing left side bunker as well.
4. Open up drainageway on the left side of the green. Add rock weirs as needed to control drainage bed erosion over time.
5. Shift cart path to the right side of the green to create better access.
6. Expand zoysia fairway around green to improve conditioning and playability.
7. Modify tee surfaces to create maximum useable tee surface area.
